Official Rules | First Summer Paycheck Program

These are the Official Rules for the 2025 “First Summer Paycheck” program offered by Altabank, Division of Glacier Bank. By participating in the program, entrants and/or their parent or legal guardian agree to be bound by these office rules.

Eligibility. Eligible participants must be between the of ages 12-18. Participants must have a checking or savings account with Altabank. Accounts can be opened at the same time of program participation.

1. **Participation.** To participate in the program, the participant must bring proof of being paid to any Altabank branch In Utah or Idaho. Examples of proof include a paystub, paycheck, or cash with a note from the employer confirming employment. Deposit of the paycheck or cash into the participant's Altabank checking or savings account is not required.

2. **Effective Dates.** The First Summer Paycheck program runs May 2025 - August 2025. Program may be discontinued by Altabank at any time.

3. **Payments.** Altabank will pay eligible participants a one-time \$25 when they bring proof of payment to the branch. Payment will be made in the form of a deposit to the participant's Altabank checking or savings account. Participants with multiple accounts may designate which account the payment goes to.

4. **Social Media Posts.** From time-to-time Altabank may create social media posts to promote the First Summer Paycheck program. By participating in the program Altabank reserves the right to use the participant's name and likeness in social media. Participants under the age of 18 are required to have a parent or legal guardian's permission to have their name and likeness used in social media. Altabank will not make public any other personally identifiable information including, but not limited to, age, grade level, address, phone number, account information, or amount deposited as part of the program.

5. **Taxes.** All applicable taxes, including any federal, state, or local tax liabilities, are the sole responsibility of the student and/or student's parent or legal guardian. Altabank will issue program participants the appropriate 1099-INT to use for tax reporting as required.
